SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS AVAILABLE

Scholarship funds are awarded on a first-come basis as funds allow, while ensuring representation from all of the South Carolina local education agencies (LEAs). Scholarship funds pay for tuition and textbook costs in CREATE-sponsored programs at specified institutions of higher education that lead to initial, alternative, and add-on licensure.

*Must be nominated by LEA administration and meet eligibility requirements.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Individuals employed full-time (instructional and non-instructional positions) by a South Carolina public/charter school are eligible.

Other eligibility criteria are required for certain credential areas (see Credentials | Programs link at website).

The CREATE scholarship program is not intended for school site and LEA leaders and administrators.
